

**Versailles Village Public Hearing
Held at Community Room**

July 10, 2019

Mayor Subler called the Public Hearing to order at 6:55 p.m.

Roll call found the following Council Members present: Mr. Paulus, Mr. Berger, Mr. Dammeyer, Mr. Beasley, Mr. Griesdorn, and Mr. Steinbrunner. Also present were Village Administrator Hale, Fiscal Officer Ording, and Village Attorney Guillozet.

Fiscal Officer Ording provided an overview of the proposed 2020 Tax Budget must be submitted to the Darke County Auditor by July 20th of each year. She noted that the budget was prepared using the list of 2020 Capital Improvement projects as adopted in the Five Year Capital Improvement Plan. She explained that the Finance & Audit Committee met on June 26th to review the budget. Among the items discussed was the 2020 plan to purchase a refuse truck. The balance in the Refuse Truck Fund of \$165,000 would be used with the remaining balance of approximately \$85,000 coming from the Refuse & Recycling Fund. Village Administrator Hale said this will be looked at as the 2020 budget is prepared. The amount of monies transferred from the Refuse & Recycling Fund to the Refuse Truck Fund is currently 7% of previous year collections. At one time it was 10%. It may be that the truck is not replaced in 2020 in order to build the Refuse Truck Fund. Refuse rates will also be evaluated.

With no further discussion on the proposed budget, Mr. Griesdorn made a motion to adjourn the Public Hearing with Mr. Berger seconding the motion. Vote: all yeas.

Mayor Subler adjourned the Public Hearing at 6:59 p.m.
