Versailles Village Public Hearing Held at Community Room

Mayor Subler called the Public Hearing to order at 6:55 p.m.

Roll call found the following Council Members present: Mr. Paulus, Mr. Berger, Mr. Beasley, Mr. Griesdorn, and Mr. Steinbrunner. Mr. Dammeyer was absent. Also present were Village Administrator Hale, Fiscal Officer Ording, Village Attorney Guillozet, and Mr. Tom Jokerst.

Fiscal Officer Ording provided an overview of the proposed 2019 Tax Budget that must be submitted to the Darke County Auditor by July 20th of each year. She noted that the budget was prepared using the list of 2019 Capital Improvement projects as adopted in the Five Year Capital Improvement Plan. An Executive Summary of the 2019 Tax Budget was prepared to explain how the budget was developed. Mr. Jokerst inquired about the ½% Income Tax Fund. The 2018 revenues reported included monies received for the 2018 street projects. It was also noted that the ½% Income Tax Renewal Levy would be placed on the 2019 ballot.

With no further discussion on the proposed budget, Mr. Paulus made a motion to adjourn the Public Hearing with Mr. Berger seconding the motion. Vote: all yeas.
