

**Versailles Village Public Hearing
Held at Community Room**

September 25, 2019

In the absence of Mayor Subler, Council President Pro Tempore Paulus called the Public Hearing to order at 6:49 p.m.

Roll call found the following Council Members present: Mr. Paulus, Mr. Berger, Mr. Beasley, Mr. Griesdorn, and Mr. Steinbrunner. Mr. Dammeyer was absent. Also present were Village Administrator Hale and Fiscal Officer Ording.

Village Administrator Hale presented the Planning Commission's recommendation regarding the zoning classification for a 50.535 acre tract of land located along Klipstine Road which is to be annexed into the Village of Versailles. The recommendation is for the zoning classification of R-1, Single Family Residential. He explained that the R-1 classification is the strictest residential classification. No dwelling can house multiple families, meaning that there is only one address per dwelling. It does not mean that the dwelling can't be a rental. It would follow the same rules of a single family with one address.

Mr. Berger made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Mr. Steinbrunner seconded the motion. Vote: all yeas.

Council President Pro Tempore Paulus adjourned the meeting at 6:54 p.m.
