

**Versailles Village Public Hearing  
Held at EMS Facility**

**November 23, 2021**

Mayor Subler called the Public Hearing to order at 6:50 p.m.

Roll call found the following Council Members present: Mr. Paulus, Mr. Berger, Mr. Beasley, Mr. Griesdorn and Mr. Steinbrunner. Mr. Dammeyer arrived at 6:51 p.m. Also present were Village Administrator Busse, Fiscal Officer Ording, and Village Attorney Guillozet.

Village Administrator Busse presented a summary of the Village's Five Year Capital Improvements Plan that were discussed during the Finance & Audit Committee meeting held on November 10, 2021. He reviewed and explained the projects planned for 2022. Among the 1/2% Income Tax Fund expenditures, \$975,000 is planned for Klipstine Road Improvements. This project is contingent upon receiving Ohio Public Works Commission grant of \$249,000 and loan of \$249,000. The total proposed projects planned for 2022 would cost \$3,919,100. He went on to review the equipment purchases for 2022. Total equipment expenditures are planned at \$177,100.

With no other discussion, Mr. Paulus made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Mr. Berger seconded the motion. Vote: all yeas.

Mayor Subler adjourned the meeting at 7:08 p.m.
