Village Reminds Residents and Contractors of Zoning/Building Permit & Inspection Requirements

With the spring season upon us, many residents and contractors are planning various construction projects. To assist in the planning of such projects, there are several things individuals should know regarding the need for obtaining local permits. The Village requires a zoning permit for many different types of construction projects. The issuance of a zoning permit certifies that the proposed structure is in compliance with the use requirements (e.g. residential, commercial, or industrial), our requirements, and setback requirements in the affected zoning district. In addition to the zoning permit, contractors, property owners, or any person performing building/renovations activities, electrical or heating and cooling work on residential properties in the Village of Versailles are required to obtain necessary permits from the Darke County Building Regulations Office, and have the necessary inspection conducted.

Village Officials encourage those of you who are considering construction plans to check into building and zoning permit regulations prior to beginning your project. This year, 1 tree will be planted, a Red Oak. Planting a new tree is an act of good faith and an attempt to make the community a better place to live. Trees will improve the environment; not just for the present generation, but also for our future generations of children and grandchildren. It is important for today's generation of people to plant and care for trees and continue the rich tradition and presence of this wonderful natural resource. Ward Park Swimming Pool season passes for 2025 are available at the Village Administrative Building, 177 North Center Street. Pass forms are also available online at www.versaillesoh.com under the Municipal/ Swimming Pool section. Please mail the completed form, along with payment to the Administrative Building or drop it off before 4:00 pm, Friday, May 23th. Beginning Monday, May 26th forms should be taken to the pool.

General Admission rates will be as follows: Ages 3 and Up - \$5.00 and Children 2 & Under are free. Season pass rates have not changed and will be as follows: Individual (18+) Pass - \$65.00; Family Pass - \$115.00. All passes purchased before Friday, May 9th will be discounted \$10.00. The Versailles Swimming Pool will open for the season on Monday, May 26th and close on Saturday, August 16th.

Please remember, family season passes are limited to immediate family members only, with at least one parent or legal guardian as the pass holder. The Village defines "Immediate Family Member" as a parent or legal guardian and their MINOR or DEPENDENT COLLEGE STUDENT children only. Adult children who live on their own or have their own families must purchase their own individual or family season pass. Also, it is not permissible to have an older sibling as the pass holder on a pass with younger siblings and it is also not permissible to add grandchildren, grandparents, cousins, babysitters, or any other non-immediate family members to a family season pass.

The Versailles Swimming Pool will be closed evenings of home swim meets. These hours will be publicized in the Village's website, Facebook page, and The Versailles Policy prior to the modified hours. Hours may be modified due to inclement weather throughout the season. Pool hours for 2025 will be Monday - Friday: 12:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.; Saturdays: 12:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.; and Sundays: 1:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
