### **Johns Sworn-in as Versailles Fire/EMS Chief**


On January 1st, the Village of Versailles swore-in Dusty Johns as Fire/EMS Chief with Mayor Todd Dammeyer administering the oath of office. Johns becomes the first full-time Fire/EMS Chief in Village history. The oath of office was administered in front of family, friends, and department personnel at the Versailles Fire & EMS Station. Johns has served with the Versailles Fire Dept. since 2003, holding a Level II Firefighter Certification and EMT Certification. He has held the position of Assistant Fire Chief for the past several years. Johns has served as an interim, part-time Fire/EMS Chief this past fall after the unexpected passing of prior Fire/EMS Chief Brian Pearson.

### **Paulus Completes Last Versailles Council Term**

Village Council Member Kent Paulus participated in his last regular council meeting on Monday, December 29th. Kent has served the residents of the Village of Versailles as a council member since 2005, ultimately deciding to not run for re-election this past fall. In addition to being a council member for the past twenty years, Kent has also participated on numerous Village committee's and boards during his tenure.

### **Griesdorn & Pepple Sworn-In as Versailles Council Members**

On January 1, 2026, Mayor Todd Dammeyer administered the oath of office to newly elected Village Council member Brent Pepple and re-elected council member Cory Griesdorn. Brent has served the Village previously on the Village's Board of Zoning Appeals before deciding to run for, and ultimately being elected to, Village Council this past fall. With Cory's re-election, he will continue with his seat on Village Council for a third term.

### Police Dept. Feasibility Study Public Hearing

Village Council will be holding a public hearing on Wednesday, February 11<sup>th</sup> for the presentation of a feasibility study for the Versailles Police Department that has been prepared by Garmann Miller. The study looked at options and cost estimates for renovating the existing Village Hall/Police Dept. Building at Main St./Center St., as well as an option for an addition onto the existing Fire/EMS Station on Baker Rd. for the Village's Police Dept. Representatives from Garmann Miller will be presenting the information from the study to those in attendance as well as answering questions. The public hearing is open to all interested parties. The public hearing has been scheduled at 6:00PM at the Versailles Fire/EMS Station Conference Room, 320 Baker Rd.

### Assistant Swimming Pool Manager

The Village of Versailles is accepting applications for the purpose of seeking qualified candidates to fill a seasonal Assistant Swimming Pool Manager position for the Versailles Ward Park Swimming Pool. Candidates must possess a high school diploma or general education degree (GED); have two years of training and/or experience in pool management, lifeguarding, or supervision supplemented by coursework in chemistry with knowledge of basic chemistry. CPR/First Aid Certification is preferred. Under administrative direction, assists the Pool Manager in managing the operation of the Village pool and directly, or indirectly, supervises all pool employees; ensures the proper maintenance of water chemistry and property operation of water filtration system. The pay range for this position is \$13.97-\$17.46 per hour. Pay will be commensurate on experience and qualifications. Lifeguard certification, first aid training, and CPR/First Aid/AED certification reimbursement is available to those candidates selected for employment by the Village.

### Street & Utility Seasonal Positions

The Village of Versailles will be accepting applications for the purpose of seeking candidates to fill temporary seasonal employment positions within the Street and Utility Departments. The candidate will be responsible for lawn mowing, painting, various sanitation duties, and other assigned general labor tasks. Candidates must be at a minimum 16 years old with a valid driver's license. These positions start at \$12.23-15.72 hour and are 40 hours per week. Pay will be commensurate on experience and qualifications.

### Lifeguard Positions

The Village of Versailles is accepting applications for the purpose of seeking qualified candidates to fill seasonal summer lifeguard positions at the Versailles Ward Park Swimming Pool. Candidates must possess lifeguard certification, first aid training, and CPR certification. The starting pay is \$11.41 -14.90 per hour. Pay will be commensurate on experience and qualifications. Lifeguard certification, first aid training, and CPR certification reimbursement is available to those candidates selected for employment by the Village.
