

Proclamation

Fire Prevention Week October 5-11, 2025. "Charge into Fire Safety: Lithium-Ion Batteries in Your Home!"



Hhereas: the Village of Versailles is committed to ensuring the safety and security of all those living in and visiting our Village; and

Exercis: fire remains a serious public safety concern both locally and nationally, and the presence of lithium-ion batteries in many household devices introduces unique fire risks; and

Exercis: most of the electronics used in homes daily, including smartphones, tablets, laptops, power tools, e-bikes, e-scooters, and toys, are powered by lithium-ion batteries, which if misued, damaged, or improperly charged, can overheat, start a fire or explode; and

Hiereas: the fire service reports an increase in battery-related fires, underscoring the need for public education on the safe use of lithium-ion batteries; and

Exercis: residents should follow three key calls to action: buy only listed products; charge batteries safely; and recycle them responsibly to prevent battery—related fires; and

Dhereas: lithium-ion batteries store a large amount of energy in a small space, and improper use such as overcharging, using off-brand chargers without safety certification, or exposing batteries to damage can result in fire or explosion; and

Exercis: the proper disposal and recycling of lithium-ion batteries helps prevent environmental hazards and reduce fire risks in the home and community; and

Hereas: the Versailles Fire Department is dedication to reducing the occurrence of fires through prevention, safety education, and community outreach; and

Hereas: The 2025 Fire Prevention Week theme, "Charge into Fire Safety: Lithium-Ion Batteries in Your Home," serves to remind us of the importance of using, charging, and recycling lithium-ion batteries safely to reduce the risk of fires in homes and communities.

Therefore, I, Todd Dammeyer, Mayor of the Village of Versailles, do hereby proclaim October 5-11th, 2025, as Fire Prevention Week throughout this community, and I urge all the people of Versailles to plan and practice a home fire escape for Fire Prevention Week 2025 and to support the many public safety activities and efforts of The Village of Versailles fire and emergency services.
