**Mosquito Fogging Scheduled**

The Village of Versailles is scheduled to be fogged for mosquitoes on Wednesday, July 9 and Wednesday, July 30 beginning at 10pm. The fogging should be completed by 12am. Residents with respiratory problems are encouraged to stay indoors and take other necessary precautions until the fog dissipates. In case of inclement weather (rain, fog, wind) on the evenings of July 9 or July 30, the fogging will be rescheduled to begin at 10pm the following night.



Through ACH processing, utility bills can be automatically deducted from your checking or saving account on the bill due date. This is a feeless service provided by the Utilities Office. ACH forms can be found on our website or picked up at the Office.

**Friday Brush and Limb pickup Reminder**

While the Village does provide brush and limb pick up, the courtesy service is not intended for picking up large piles of brush and limbs (any pile larger than a normal pick up load 4'x4'x6'). Citizens have the ability, and are encouraged, to take large piles of trimmings to the Village yard waste pile near the Village Wastewater Plant at 300 Grand Ave for discard. The Village will try to accommodate residents, but by ordinance has the discretion to request ALL brush and limbs be transported by the citizens of the Village. Please contact the Village Office to have your brush scheduled for pick up. Thank you for your cooperation.

The Village of Versailles will be starting implementation of CodeRED, a high-speed emergency mass notification service provided by OnSolve. The CodeRED service will be replacing the prior mass notification service, One Call NOW, that the Village has used for many years.

The CodeRED system will serve as the backbone of the Village of Versailles emergency planning, utility outage notifications, and communications outreach to residents and businesses. The system sends telephone calls, text messages, emails and posts to social media channels to inform residents to better protect life and property.

OnSolve has provided the Village an initial database of residential and business telephone numbers based on the contact information that was stored in the former One Call NOW service. However, all residents and utility customers with the Village are encouraged to visit [www.versaillesoh.com](http://www.versaillesoh.com) and click on the CodeRED logo near the top of the page to enroll their contact information including cell phone numbers, text and email addresses. No one should automatically assume they are in the CodeRED contact database as the Village will not enroll someone without their consent. All new utility customers with the Village are automatically enrolled in the CodeRED service unless they opt out at the time that they sign their utilities agreement.

There will be a system-wide test of the new CodeRED system on Wednesday, July 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025. During that test, all enrollees in the service will receive a notification stating that this is just a test. This will help Village staff fine-tune the system to ensure that it will work properly when needed. Utility customers who do not receive the test notification on this date are urged to visit the Village website or contact the Village Office to enroll.
