Village Reminds Residents of Pool Regulations

Residents are reminded that there are rules and regulations in place within the Village of Versailles for private swimming pool construction and operation. Rules and regulations related to pools are outlined in Section 514 of the Village's Zoning Code that can be found online at versaillesoh.com by clicking on the Government tab, selecting Zoning Regulations, and finally clicking on the Zoning Ordinance link. The rules and regulations apply to in-ground and above-ground pools. Above-ground pool kits that are available at local stores and by online order may fall under such established pool rules and regulations. Any swimming pool in excess of twenty-four (24") inches requires a zoning permit application submitted to the Village prior to any installation work beginning. There are also rules regarding fencing being required for any swimming pool, either in-ground or above-ground, that is in excess of twenty-four (24") in depth. For an above-ground pool, additional railing around the top of the pool exterior may be used in lieu of fencing, but must be reviewed and approved by the Village in advance through the zoning permit process. The Village also recommends that residents speak with their insurance carrier prior to any pool construction as they may have rules and regulations in addition to those outlined in the Village's Zoning Code.
