Regular leaf collection is scheduled to begin Monday, October 13th. Leaves will be picked up as needed until December 5th. Leaf collection routes are as follows:

Mondays: All streets south of the Board of Education Building

Tuesdays: All streets west of South Center Street

Wednesdays: All streets east of South Center Street

Thursdays: All streets north of the railroad tracks.

Please do not mix sticks, weeds, or garden foliage in with your leaves. Leaves need to be placed in the street along the curb for pick up. Please do not put leaves in plastic bags. Also, residents are asked to refrain from parking on the street on your scheduled collection day.



On Tuesday, October 7th, the Village of Versailles will conduct the final clean-up day of the year.

This will be the last clean-up day until next spring for discarding medium sized items that will not fit in the Village refuse container. Please sit items out at your normal pick up location for pick up on the morning of October 7th. We hope to be able to pick up all items on this day, however, if we cannot finish all pickups that day we will pick them up the following day(s) until we are finished.

As a reminder, 2-yard and 3-yard rental dumpsters are also available for use. Rental dumpsters will be provided for a two week period. In order to cover the expenses associated with providing this service, a fee of \$45.00 (2-yard) or \$65.00 (3-yard) will be charged each time the dumpster is emptied during the two week period.

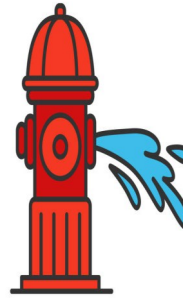
Village Park Restrooms Closing for the Season

Revisions to Village of Versailles Utilities Policies

Village Council recently adopted revised policies and procedures for the billing and collection of payment for the provision of utilities services as well as for the procedures for the provision of electric services by the Village. These revisions were made with Village Ordinance No. 25-35 and 25-36 that had their third and final readings on August 13, 2025. One of the changes with these revisions is related to when a utility account becomes delinquent. With the utility bills due October 10, 2025, utility bills will remain being due on the 10th day of each month just as they have been for numerous years. Any payment made after the 10th day of the month or without a U.S. Postal Service post-date listed on the envelope of the 10th or earlier, will be subject to late fees. Utility bills will be mailed and/or electronically issued to customers a few days earlier than what customers may have noticed in the past to provide additional time for review and payment. Earlier utility bill mailing is possible due to the Village's radio-read AMI meter system. If payment for the utility bill is not made by the 30th day of the month, a late notice with a fifteen-day disconnection notice will be issued to the customer. If payment is not received or a payment plan requested and approved by the Village within 15 days of the late/disconnection notice, all Village utilities will be disconnected for non-payment. The revised policies also include allowing disconnection of electric utilities during the winter months. Lastly, electric customers outside of the Village corporation limits no longer need to report their own electric meter readings to the Village. With the deployment of radio-read AMI electric meters, the need for self-reading is no longer needed for billing. Any remaining electric meters located outside of the Village that have not yet been converted to a radio-read AMI meter will be read by Village personnel until they are eventually replaced.
