2025 SHELTER HOUSE INFORMATION


The Village of Versailles has two publicly- owned parks available for the enjoyment of its citizens and visitors to the community. If you wish to rent a shelter house at either Ward Park or Indian Creek, please contact the Administrative Office, 937-526-3294 or stop in at 177 N Center Street. A \$50 (non-refundable) fee is due for weekend reservations (Sat, Sun), otherwise there is no cost to reserve through the week (Mon- Fri). Reservations can be made on or after January 2nd of each calendar year. Park restrooms typically open to the public the first part of April (weather dependent) and close in mid-October.



WARD PARK: located at 448 Woodland Drive, is a publicly owned park which contains three shelter houses, a swimming pool, tennis court, pickleball court, ball diamond, restroom facility, and playground equipment.

Ward Park Swimming Pool: open to the public from the end of May through the middle of August.

INDIAN CREEK: located on 767 Jackson Street or 574 Baker Road, is a publicly owned park containing two shelter house with restroom facilities, basketball court, tennis court, ball diamond, cornhole boards, pickleball courts and playground equipment.
