Village Issues Reminder on Parking of Recreational Vehicles



The Village of Versailles wishes to provide a reminder to residents on the parking regulations pertaining to recreational vehicles (RV's), water craft, dirt bikes, motorized sport vehicles, and utility trailers. Parking regulations pertaining to these vehicles can be found in Section 416 of the Village of Versailles Zoning Code. Parked or stored camping and recreational equipment as defined in the Zoning Code shall not be connected for a period of more than forty-eight (48) hours to electricity and water, and at no time shall this equipment be used for living purposes. If the camping and recreational equipment is parked or stored outside a garage, it shall be parked or stored to the rear of the home and must be at least three (3) feet from any lot line. If a recreational vehicle is parked along a street, all slide-outs and awnings must be retracted so they do not block vehicular traffic of the street nor pedestrian use of the sidewalk area. Lastly, all on-property parking or storage areas for any passenger vehicles and/or recreational vehicles in any residential area must be constructed of a hard surface such as concrete or asphalt.

Plan Ahead...

On Tuesday, October 6th, the Village of Versailles will conduct the final clean-up day of the year. This will be the last clean-up day until next spring for discarding medium sized items that will not fit in the Village refuse container. Please sit items out at your normal pick up location for pick up on the morning of October 6th. We hope to be able to pick up all items on this day, however, if we cannot finish all pickups that day we will pick them up the following day(s) until we are finished.

This fall clean-up day is intended for items that are too large to fit into the refuse container and would not normally require an additional charge to collect. Normal trash in your Village refuse container will still be picked up on your designated day that week. **This pickup of medium items is in addition to your normal trash pickup!**

Collection: follows calendar to the right

Brush Collection: (place by the curb) sticks, branches, twigs, etc.

Refuse Large Items and Brush Collection

There has been an uptick in large refuse items such as recliners, appliances, and other such large household items being sat out at the curb in various locations without the customer calling the Village Utility Office to schedule a large item pickup. The Village will gladly collect such large items for \$15 (each item) by the customer calling the Village Utility Office at (937) 526-3294 with office hours being 7:30A-4:00P M-F. Customers may also email such requests to utilities@versaillesoh.com any time of the day. The cost for the large item pickup will be automatically added to your monthly utility bill. The Village also provides weekly brush collection service at the curb side of the customer every Friday at no cost to the property owner. However, you must contact the Village Utility Office to be added to the collection list as Village personnel do not run a street-by-street route for this free service. Brush collection is separate from the bi-weekly Yard Waste Collection Service. The Village is happy to provide these services to the residents of Versailles to help keep our community clean and appealing for the betterment of all.
