

Proclamation

Fire Prevention Week October 6-12, 2024. "Smoke Alarms: Make Them Work For You!"

Hhereas: the Village of Versailles is committed to ensuring the safety and security of all those living in and visiting our Village; and

Hereas: Fire is a serious public safety concern both locally and nationally, and homes are the locations where people are at greatest risk from fire; and

Hereas: Home fires caused 2,700 civilian deaths in the United States in 2022, according to the National Fire Protection Association® (NFPA®), and fire departments in the United States responded to 360,000 home fires; and

Exercis: Roughly three out of five fire deaths happen in homes with either no smoke alarms or with no working smoke alarms; and

Dhereas: Working smoke alarms cut the risk of dying in reported home fires almost in half; and

Hhereas: Smoke alarms sense smoke well before you can, alerting you to danger in the event of fire in which you may have as little as 2 minutes to escape safely; and

Hereas: Village residents should install smoke alarms in every sleeping room, outside each separate sleeping area, and on every level of the home; and

Exercis: Village residents will make sure their smoke alarms meet the needs of all their family members, including those with sensory or physical disabilities; and

Whereas: Village residents should test smoke alarms at least once a month.

Hereas: Residents who have planned and practiced a home fire escape plan are more prepared and will therefore be more likely to survive a fire; and

Dhereas: Village first responders are dedicated to reducing the occurrence of home fires and home fire injuries through prevention and protection education; and

Hiereas: Village residents are responsive to public education measures and are able to take personal steps to increase their safety from fire, especially in their homes; and

Dhereas: The 2024 Fire Prevention Week theme, "Smoke Alarms: Make them work for you.", serves to remind us the importance of having working smoke alarms in the home.

Therefore, I, Todd Dammeyer, Mayor of the Village of Versailles, do hereby proclaim October 6-12th, 2024, as Fire Prevention Week throughout this community, and I urge all the people of Versailles to plan and practice a home fire escape for Fire Prevention Week 2024 and to support the many public safety activities and efforts of The Village of Versailles fire and emergency services.
