Proclamation



Hhereas: In 1872, J. Sterling Morton proposed to the Nebraska Board of Agriculture that a special day be set aside for the planting of trees; and

Example 19 this holiday, called Arbor Day, was first observed with the planting of more than a million trees in Nebraska; and

Phereas: Arbor Day is now observed throughout the nation and the world; and

Exercis: trees can reduce the erosion of our precious topsoil by wind and water, cut heating and cooling costs, moderate the temperature, clean the air, produce life-giving oxygen, and provide habitat for wildlife; and

Exercis: trees are a renewable resource giving us paper, wood for our homes, fuel for our fires, and countless other wood products; and

Exercis: trees in our village increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of business areas, and beautify our community; and

Exercis: trees, wherever they are planted, are a source of joy and spiritual renewal.

Dow, Therefore, I, Todd Dammeyer, Mayor of the Village of Versailles, do hereby proclaim April 26, 2024 as

Arbor Day

in the Village of Versailles, and I urge all citizens to celebrate $Arbor\ Day$ and to support efforts to protect our trees and woodlands; and

Jurther, I urge all citizens to plant trees to gladden the heart and promote the well-being of this and future generations.
