**Yard Waste:** (must be in container) grass, garden forage, flower discards, leaves, etc.

Collection: follows calendar below

**Brush Collection:** (place by the curb) sticks, branches, twigs, etc.

Collection: year round on Fridays, must call into the Office to get scheduled

**Leaf Collection:** (place by the curb) leaves only

Collection: to begin October 12th and last through December 4th (weekly route on flip side)



# VILLAGE OF VERSAILLES GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES FOR BRUSH, YARD WASTE, LEAF & RECYCLING COLLECTION



## Brush:

- If you would like your brush to be collected, you must call into the Utilities Office prior to Friday of that week. Office# 937-526-3294
- Pieces of brush should be a maximum of 4 feet in length and 4 inches in diameter. If you have pieces that are larger than this, other arrangements will have to be made to transport the pieces to the yard waste pile.
- Brush should be stacked on a pile with all brush laying in the same direction. Any brush or limb pile larger than a normal load (approximately 4' x 4' x 6') will not be picked up and residents will be notified and requested to transport the brush or limbs to the yard waste pile.

## Yard Waste:

- If you forget to set your yard waste out, please feel free to take the yard waste to the Wastewater Treatment Plant (300 Grand Avenue - Compost pile at the top of the hill) for disposal at any time. DO NOT PLACE YARD WASTE IN PLASTIC BAGS FOR COLLECTION OR DISPOSAL.. Yard waste must be placed in containers that can be easily dumped by Village personnel.

## Recycling Reminders:

- Please place your RECYCLABLES at your normal garbage collection location. Do not place your commingled recyclables in plastic bags. Items must be loose inside your recycling bin.
- Please do not mix corrugated cardboard boxes in with your recyclables. These items are not picked up by the Village as part of the commingled recyclable collection. Corrugated cardboard boxes may be recycled by breaking them down, then bringing them to the Village's cardboard compactor located at 355 Grand Avenue.
- Paperboard boxes, such as cereal boxes, and glossy magazines are accepted with the weekly commingled recyclable collection.

## Leaf Collection Schedule: (October 12th– December 4th)

Mondays: All streets south of the Board of Education Building

Tuesdays: All streets west of South Center Street

Wednesdays: All streets east of South Center Street

Thursdays: All streets north of the railroad tracks.

- Please do not mix grass, sticks, weeds, or garden foliage in with your leaves. Leaves need to be placed in the street along the curb for pick up. Please do not put leaves in plastic bags. Also, residents are asked to refrain from parking on the street on your scheduled collection day.
