

MINUTES
Park Board Meeting
July 25, 2019

The Park Board meeting was held at the Village Administration building and began at 7:30 a.m.

Those individuals in attendance were Marilyn Griesdorn, Ted Baltes, Connie Apple, Chairman Todd Dammeyer, Larry Hemmelgarn, Utilities Superintendent Kyle Francis, and Village Administrator Rodd Hale.

A motion was made by Connie Apple, seconded by Marilyn Griesdorn, to approve the agenda. Vote: all yeas.

A motion to approve the May 30, 2019 meeting minutes was made by Marilyn Griesdorn, seconded by Ted Baltes. Vote: all yeas.

Discussion regarding swimming pool operations was held. Administrator Hale reported attendance has been good and it appears we have gotten a handle on getting the correct amount of chlorine mixed into the pool. Last year this was a problem but it seems to have stabilized. In general the pool operations are going smoothly in 2019.

Regarding the fence that was removed from around the Indian Creek Park shuffleboard courts, it was reported by Connie Apple that she felt it looked much better without the fence and everyone seemed to be in agreement. The removal of the fence has also made it easier to mow and keep trimmed.

Discussion then turned to the possibility of placing sidewalks from the swimming pool parking lot to the tennis courts and adding concrete up near the bleachers and shed area to allow for a sidewalk entrance into the tennis courts. Citizen Larry Hemmelgarn stated that it's often wet and muddy and it looks bad for out of town visitors coming to our Park. Kyle Francis stated there may need to be steps incorporated into the sidewalk due to the slope down to the parking lot. In general it was felt the sidewalks and adding concrete where the batting cage is would be a positive and should be recommended to the Village Council. Connie Apple made a motion, seconded by Marilyn Griesdorn to recommend to the Village Council the Village proceed with completing the sidewalks and concrete areas. Vote: all yeas.

With no further business to conduct a motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Ted Baltes, seconded by Connie Apple. Vote: all yeas.
